Gérard Houllier OBE was National Technical Director of the French World Cup Winning Team of 1998. He is the former Manager of Liverpool Football Club, French Champions Lyon and Aston Villa FC. In 2012, Gérard became the Sporting Director at Salzburg FC in Austria.

In detail

From 1982-1985, Gérard was the Manager of Lens, earning UEFA Cup qualification and from 1985-1986 he was Manager of Paris St. Germain, winning the French Championship in 1986. He worked as number two to the National French Team Head Coach, Michel Platini, for the European Championship of 1988 and 1992, later progressing to Head Coach of France. He was the Manager of Liverpool Football Club from 1998-2004 and under his leadership Liverpool became the first club to win three knock-out competitions in one season. In 2005 he became the Manager of French Champions Lyon and was manager of Aston Villa FC from September 2010 to June 2011. In 2012, Gérard became the Sporting Director at Salzburg FC in Austria. He is one of the most respected management figures in world football and one of the most knowledgeable people in the game. He was awarded an OBE in 2003.
