Jaron Lanier is a computer scientist, composer, artist, and author who writes on numerous topics, including high-technology business, the social impact of technology, Internet politics, and the future of humanism. Jaron has been on the cusp of technological innovation from its infancy to the present. A pioneer in virtual reality (a term he coined), Jaron founded VPL Research, the first company to sell VR products, and led teams creating virtual reality applications for medicine, design, and numerous other fields. He is currently an Interdisciplinary Scientist at Microsoft Research.

Jaron Lanier is also a musician and artist. He has been active in the world of new "classical" music since the late '70's, and writes chamber and orchestral works. He is a pianist and a specialist in unusual and historical musical instruments, and maintains one of the largest and most varied collections of actively played instruments in the world. Janier's writing appears in Discover, The Wall Street Journal, Forbes, Harpers Magazine, Atlantic, Wired Magazine (where he was a founding contributing editor), and Scientific American. He has appeared on TV shows such as PBS NewsHour, The Colbert Report, Nightline and Charlie Rose, and has been profiled on the front pages of The Wall Street Journal and The New York Times multiple times.
