Prof. Porras received his BSEE from Texas Western College, his MBA from Cornell University, and his PhD from the University of California. Among the honours he has received are the Brilliant Award from the National Society of Hispanic MBAs, the Silver Apple Award from the Stanford Business School Alumni Association and the Kanter Medal from the Pacific Graduate School of Psychology. He served as a Business School Trust Faculty Fellow as well as a Robert M. and Anne T. Bass Faculty Fellow. He was also the Associate Dean of Academic Affairs at the Graduate School of Business from 1991-1994.
