He serves on the Board of the International Peace Institute and was Visiting Scholar from 2013 to 2014 at the Rothermere American Institute, Oxford. From 2005 to 2007 he was Anchor and World Affairs Commentator for Sky News. Mr. Rubin received a Bachelor of Arts degree in Political Science and a Masters in International Affairs from Columbia University.
